

New Course Offering: Mentor-Coach Processes for School Leaders

Are you interested in learning more about successful mentoring and coaching in your school? Consider taking Mentor-Coach Processes for School Leaders, an online course sponsored by the Virginia Foundation for Educational Leadership. Classes will be held each Wednesday between January 23 and May 8, 2019.

This course provides participants with an opportunity to delve into the roles that mentors and coaches serve in the continued growth and development of school leaders, with particular emphasis on principals and assistant principals. Individuals will explore the roles of mentor and coach through readings, group discussions, and first-hand experiences with group and individual sessions.

During this course, enrollees will actively engage in activities that allow each to have mentor/mentee and coach/coachee experiences that they can, in turn, apply to work/school situations. Participants will immerse themselves in coaching through individual leadership coaching sessions.

Seminar formats include whole group through online webinars, group coaching through online video platform Zoom, and individual coaching sessions via telephone. Learning will be reinforced through active research, reflection activities, and projects directly related to
